Q: I don't have any health insurance, how can I get medical care for my family?

A: In response to the potential growth of Coronavirus (COVID-19) cases, the Washington Health Benefit Exchange has announced a limited-time special enrollment period for qualified individuals who are currently without health insurance. This special enrollment period runs through April 8, 2020. Additional resources are below:

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Q: What if I cannot afford to pay for my COVID-19 test?

A: Testing for COVID-19 is now covered by the State of Washington for all residents. Governor Inslee announced state plans to cover the costs of COVID-19 tests for residents **without health insurance**. Additionally, State Insurance Commissioner Mike Kreidler issued an order **to Washington health insurers** to cover required COVID-19 testing and provider visits **without copays or deductibles**. That order is in effect through May 4th. People who think they may have symptoms should call their doctor's office (please do not go in person) or call a public health clinic.
